

Entry Fee: \$225 (\$25 USHJA Entrant Fee included in the entry fee)

SPECIFICATIONS:

- * Open to all eligible horses.
- Each horse/rider combination must compete a separate USHJA Exhibitor Declaration Form no later than one hour prior ro the start of the class.
- * The order of go will be posted minimum of one (1) hour prior to the start of the class.
- Horses entered in this class will not be required to jog for soundness. Any unsoundness during the competition will be reflected in the scores from the judges. (GR 1031.7).
- ★ During the 2 phases of the National Hunter Derby, all horses entered must be ridden only in the designated National Hunter Classic warm-up area wearing their classic competition number.
- * Two round classic with Fence heights 3'0" and four option fences set at 3'3" to 3'5".
- * Formal dress attire required (HU126)

JUDGING:

- * Horse/rider combinations will receive one (1) bonus point for every high option jumped without major fault up to a max of four (4) in both rounds.
- * Each class must have a minimum of 2 judges.
- Numeric round scores and bonus points will be announced separately and will be combined for the total round 2 score.
- * Round 1 and 2 scores will be combined to determine final placings.
- In the case of a tie in the overall placings, the handy round scores will be used to break any ties. There will not be a jump off for a tie breaker.
- ★ Highest Placing Jr/Am to be awarded

Round 1 Hunter Classic Course:

To be shown over a hunter classic type course consisting of a minimum of 10 fences/obstacles that simulate those reminiscent of the hunt field and a variety of derby jumps will be used. Fence heights set at 3'0". There must be four 3'3" to 3'5" fences set as option jumps. To be judged on performance, hunter pace and style, quality and substance, movement and brilliance. A minimum of (12) entries, including horses tied for 12th place must return for round 2, if available.

Round 2 Handy Hunter Course:

Course will consist of a minimum of 8 obstacles and will include a minimum of two required "handy options". Fence height 3'0". Four options set at 3'3" to 3'5" will be included. To be judged on style, brilliance and handiness.

*Be sure to check Pet Policy when reserving.

A division must have at least 4 horses and 2 riders to count. No model points to count.



HOW TO PREPARE YOURSELF FOR THE SHOW RING

Friday, June 23 - 7:15-8:00 am Grandstand Ring
Open to all (no charge)

Hear from a Bryan Trophy winning trainer and former Best Turned Out winner, Maria Shannon, and 'R' rated Judge, Eric Dirks, on how to prepare yourself for the show ring to be successful. Walking into the ring takes confidence, preparation and a team effort from your trainers and grooms. Learn how to help yourself be prepared the day of the show. We will discuss proper attire and dress, tack needs for hunters versus equitation, learning your courses, mental preparation, preparing your horse, and other things you can do to help yourself win. Also hear about the Judges first impression when you walk in the ring and what they first notice and what they do and do not want to see.

Eric Dirks has been a professional rider/trainer in Virginia since 1986. As part of Hampden Row, alongside Jan Simpson and Katherine Schmidt Butler, Eric enjoys developing young hunters as well as training junior and amateur riders. Eric has been a 'R' rated judge with the USEF for the past 12 years and has judged shows all over the country.

Maria Shannon grew up at the Barracks, learning from Claiborne Bishop and Glenn Moody. In 1996, Maria graduated from Hollins University where she majored in Studio Art and minored in Sociology. While in school, Maria rode on the Hollins IHSA team. She won the individual open over fences class at Nationals in 1993 and 1995. Following graduation, she worked as barn manager for Will Coleman at Fox Ridge. While working at Fox Ridge, she showed "Wincer" in the A/O jumpers. Maria turned professional in 1998 and began riding young horses at the Barracks while still working at Fox Ridge. In 2000, she took a full time position at the Barracks and has remained there since, teaching lessons and riding horses in the professional divisions.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current Federation Rule Book, VHSA, MHSA, NCHJA rule books will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith.

ENTRIES

PRE-ENTRIES CLOSE MONDAY, JUNE 5. Each section or class

will be limited and entries will be accepted upon receipt of completed entry blank. Entries must be accompanied by payment for stabling or an "open" check and must be signed by the owner (or his authorized agent), trainer, and rider/handler (parent/guardian if minor).

POST ENTRIES Space permitting, post entries in performance classes will be accepted with a \$35 late fee per horse.

NON-NEGOTIABLE CHECKS incur \$50 processing fee, plus collection costs.

CLASS ADDS Adds must be made in the horse show office on the official form. No fee for adds done by the evening before the class. Space permitting, class adds "the day of" will be accepted per management discretion.

SHOW SCRATCHES No fee for show scratches with a veterinary certificate received by the start of the division entered or issued by the official horse show vet. *\$35 fee for show scratches without a veterinary certificate.*

CLASS SCRATCHES Scratches must be made in the horse show office on the official form. No fee for scratches made in the horse show office anytime before the class begins. Where horses/riders are entered but not exhibited, but not scratched before the first class of the division, the exhibitor shall be responsible for the entry fees.

STABLING: Reserve Early – stalls are limited!

- Stall fees are \$230 per stall, no initial bedding provided.
 Stall fees are not refundable.
- Horses with stalls who are not entered in classes will be charged a \$100 non-showing horse fee.
- 100 permanent stalls that are 10x10 supplemented by solid-side vinyl canvas portable stalls with self supporting roof, all with lights and doors, will be available from Monday, June 19 to Sunday, June 25. Special arrangements must be made through the Secretary for arrival prior to Monday, June 19, or departure after Sunday, June 25.
- Stalls belong to the Deep Run Horse Show. All stalls must be reserved through the Secretary. Stall assignments will be made by the Stable Manager and any changes must be authorized by the Stable Manager. The Deep Run Horse Show reserves the right to re-sell stalls. Feed, hay and bedding will be available for purchase on the grounds. Orders must be placed with the stabling office and in the name of the exhibitor to be billed. An open check will be required before orders can be delivered.

- Permanent stalls have floor mats or packed ground with metal stall gates. Portable stalls have grass floors with metal stall doors.
- Exhibitors will be held responsible for damages or alterations to stalls, including punctures. If unsure, show management should be consulted; otherwise charges for any damage or alteration will be billed to exhibitor (noting the trainer) on record.
- A grounds fee of \$30 per horse will be charged to all entries which show over fences and do not purchase a stall.

PARKING All cars, vans, and trailers must be parked in designated areas only. Vans and trailers may not be parked in the stable area. Exhibitors must observe Fire Lane regulations. Vans and trailers bringing animals for the day are required to park in a specified area where water will be available.

MEDICAL WASTE Biohazards medical waste must be placed in the proper receptacles. Anyone, including trainers, owners, exhibitors, or their agents, found in violation shall be subject to a fine or other penalties deemed necessary by show management.

BEFORE NUMBERS MAY BE PICKED UP All participants (rider, handler, owner, trainer, agent or lessee) must present their current USEF and USHJA membership cards, or a copy to the show secretary.

VACCINE REQUIREMENT Per USEF GR845, horses entering the show grounds must be accompanied by documentation of Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhinopneumonitis) vaccinations within six months prior to entering the stables. Horses not in compliance with this rule may be required to leave the competition grounds upon request by competition management. A form can be found on our website.

THE STATE OF VIRGINIA REQUIRES THE SHOW TO POSSESS A COPY OF A CURRENT (WITHIN 12 MONTHS) NEGATIVE COGGINS CERTIFICATE FROM EVERY HORSE ON THE SHOW GROUNDS. THE COGGINS CERTIFICATE MUST BE PRESENTED AT THE HORSE SHOW OFFICE BEFORE NUMBERS CAN BE PICKED UP.

USEF MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above, Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage Competitions, Endurance Rides and Vaulting Competitions: (See GR828.4 of the Federation rules). Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, or agent, at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot (exception: Friesian performance FR231) and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes

RIDING & SCHOOLING

SCHOOLING

Rings are 150' x 275' with all weather footing. Ticketed schooling at \$40 per horse will be offered on Tuesday, June 20, at 10:00 a.m. in Grandstand, and at 11:00 a.m. in Eastern Meadows. *After June 20 there will be no schooling over fences in the ring at any time*. At management's discretion, flatwork and hand walking may be allowed up to 30 minutes prior to the start of the show each morning. Separate warm up areas will be provided. Warm up areas are both natural turf and all weather footing. Separate lunging area with fence and all weather footing.

All exhibitors and riders must wear properly fastened protective headgear which meets or exceeds ASTM/SEI standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag – Harness must be secured and properly fitted.

STARTING ORDER

Unless otherwise stated, the starting order for all classes will be in accordance with Rule HU156.

COURTESY CIRCLE

In all classes the courtesy circle may be restricted and will be indicated on the course diagram and a corresponding barrier will be erected in the arena.

JOG

Horses/ponies are required to trot a circle on a loose rein at the end of each over fences performance. Horses/ponies may be asked to return to the ring and trot another circle at the judge's discretion.

AWARDS

Prize money will be credited at the horse show upon check-out. Ribbon winners in classes not to jog should be prepared to return to the ring for awards. Trophies, along with Champion and Reserve awards, will be presented in the ring. Ribbons will be awarded 1-8 in all classes. Total prize money offered is \$36,600. Total prize money guaranteed is \$5,000.00 2022 Total prize money offered: \$36,600. 2022 Total paid: \$35,321

DOGS

Dogs must be leashed or confined at all times. Any violation will subject the owner to a \$25 fine. Owners are required to have evidence of their dog's current rabies vaccination.

SAFE SPORT STATEMENT

All USEF Life and Senior Active members, as well as participants who have regular contact with minor athletes, are required to comply with the U.S. Center for SafeSport training requirement to be eligible to participate in the competition. All participants must adhere to the U.S. Center for SafeSport Code, USEF Safe Sport Policy, and the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies. More information about these can be found at www.usef.org

USEF MOTORIZED VEHICLE STATEMENT

Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

MANAGEMENT RESERVATIONS

In accordance with the 1989 Federal Waste Tracking Act, bio-hazardous medical waste containers are provided in the stable area. All exhibitors and their agents are responsible for proper disposal of this waste.

Exhibitors are notified that any act of discourtesy or disobedience to the judges or officials, on the part of the owner, manager, rider, or groom shall disqualify the horse, and the owner shall forfeit his entry fee and other fees

Questions or disputes not covered in these rules and regulations shall be referred to Show Management, whose decision shall be final.








PHASE 1 Course consisting of a minimum of 8 obstacles over a hunter type course. Course should consist of: combination (including an oxer) and at least two changes of direction after the first obstacle.

At least two of the following: Roll back turn, bending line, narrow jump, fence at the end of the ring, long approach to the single jump. To be judged on seat, hands, guidance, and control of the horse. Using the numerical scoring format for phase 1 and phase 1 will consist of 50% of the overall placing.

PHASE 2 After completion of the jumping phase a minimum of twelve (12) riders, if available, are required to show at a walk, trot and canter. Judges may call for more advanced flatwork from Test 1-16. The flat performance of those riders selected to show in the flat phase shall count 50%.

PHASE 3 A minimum of 3 riders will be asked to exhibit any additional individual requirements of horsemanship the judges may deem necessary. This may include but not limited to Test 1 - 16.

This is a perpetual trophy. The name of the winner will be engraved thereon. Eight ribbons will be presented.
